LEARNING FROM JESUS' RELATIONSHIPS From surface to significance through serving

1. Serve without **RECOGNITION**

"Jesus knew that His hour had come to leave this world and return to His Father. He now showed the disciples the full extent of His love...So He got up from the table, took off His robe, wrapped a towel around His waist, and poured water into a basin. Then He began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel He had around Him... 'I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you.'" John 13:1,4,5,15

2. Serve with **COMPASSION**

"...Jesus loved Martha, Mary, and Lazarus...Then He told them plainly, 'Lazarus is dead...' Jesus wept." John 11:1-44

3. Serve with **TRUTH**

"Jesus turned and looked at His disciples and then said to Peter very sternly, "Get away from Me, Satan! You are seeing things merely from a human point of view, not from God's." Mark 8:33

"Peter said, 'Lord, I am ready to go to prison with You, and even to die with You.' But Jesus said, 'Peter, let Me tell you something. The rooster will not crow tomorrow morning until you have denied three times that you even know Me.'" Luke 22:33-34

"Jesus replied, 'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' All the other commandments and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments."
